PRESENTATION BY GENEVA HISTORY CENTER:

David Oberg, Executive Director, Tricia Stewart, President, and Dick Lewis, Board Member, gave a history of the center, outlined its programs and discussed membership. Even though membership has increased and attendance at events has increased, donations to the center have decreased by almost 50%. Due to the economic climate, the Geneva History Center has found its budget short about \$150,000.00. Mr. Lewis asked Geneva Township to consider a donation to the History Center.

REPORTS:

SENIOR CENTER DIRECTOR Gayle Kennedy gave an update on October events and noted that 24 were in attendance for the Art Institute trip. Gayle asked if the trustees had a policy for tipping bus drivers. After discussion, it was the consensus that tipping a bus driver should be voluntary. Gayle asked for \$500.00 to pay for the cost of producing the Geneva Township Senior Center cookbook. Committee members, working on the cookbook, plan to sell it for \$5.00 per copy. A request was submitted from the Geneva Park District to use the building to host a party for 200 children. Trustees voiced their concern about the facility and its appropriateness for 200 children. Supervisor Jaeger will meet with park district personnel to clarify the request.
