The Yellow Dot Could Save Your Life

On Thursday, September 13 from 12:30 - 3:00pm TRIAD members will be at the Center to help you sign up for the Illinois Yellow Dot Program. As was discussed in last month's newsletter, the program, an Illinois Department of Transportation initiative, records and makes available vital medical and emergency information on a vehicle's driver and passengers to first responders in the event of an automobile accident or medical emergency while in your car. A photo will be taken by a TRIAD volunteer and affixed to a form you complete with emergency and medical details. The form is placed in your glove compartment. The Yellow Dot sticker is placed on the car's rear window to alert first responders that medical information can be found in the glove box. Volunteers from TRIAD will assist you, if you wish, with the completion of every step. Please bring a list of your medications and dosages, medical insurance information, and emergency and physician contacts. Center members are also welcome to complete the form provided by TRIAD at home and affix the sticker yourself. A photo will be taken for your takehome kit. Call with questions or stop by the Center and pick up a brochure that further explains this program.

A Day Out With the Garden Club

Join us **Thursday, September 20**, as we experience a bygone era with a morning visit to the Ellwood House in DeKalb and then, weather permitting, move on to Jonamac Orchard amongst the farm fields of Malta, Illinois.

Built by barbed wire millionaire Isaac L. Ellwood in 1879, the Ellwood House remains with its original furnishings just as when the family lived there decades ago. Tour the great English living room with its vast stone fireplace, the mahogany-paneled dining room, and the magnificent rotunda with a threestory spiral staircase. The site provides a glimpse of

a complete household at the turn of the twentieth century.

Following a picnic lunch in the Ellwood garden we will travel a few more miles west to Malta. At Jonamac we can relax with some fresh apple pie or venture into the orchard to pick apples to bring home.



The cost for the trip is **\$28** which covers the bus and entry fees. We need a minimum of 12 people to make the trip a "go." **The bus will leave the Center at 9 am and return by 2 pm.** In the case of stormy weather, we will omit the apple picking and return to the Center early. Bring a sack lunch. Beverages will be provided.

Daily Drop-In Activities

The following activities are available whenever the Center is open, Monday through Friday, 8:30-4:30. It's all free; no need to sign up!

- **Billiards:** 8-ball and 9-ball, on the porch when the porch is not scheduled for other activities. The players tend to be there Tuesday and Wednesday mornings. Also, you can always practice on your own.

Free Flu Shot Clinic Set in October

Geneva Township is once again sponsoring a free flu shot clinic. The clinic is sched-

uled for Monday, October 8 (Columbus Day) from 9:00 to 12:00 noon. Nurses from the Visiting Nurses Association of Fox Valley will administer the shots. Seniors signed up for Medicare Part B will have the cost of their flu shots covered by Medicare. Please bring your Medicare card. Geneva Township will pay the cost of the flu shot for any Geneva Township resident age 55+ not covered by Medicare Part B. For all others the cost of the flu shot is \$20.00 and the cost of the pneumonia shot is \$70.00. Again this year the DPT (diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis) shot will also be offered. The cost of the DPT shot is



\$45.00. A doctor's prescription will be required for any shot other than the flu shot. Any payment must be by cash or check only. Seniors who need transportation to the Center should contact Sheri no later than **October 1**st. As always, free snacks and refreshments will be served.
