
Ladies Happy New Year Tea

AARP Tax Preparers Back in February

With the holidays behind us, it's time to start thinking about and preparing for tax season. Starting in February, volunteer AARP preparers will again assist Center members on **Tuesday and Thursday** each week with the completion and filing of 2012 Federal and IL tax returns.

AARP volunteers are trained and tested in current tax law using materials from the IRS. They can complete most tax forms including 1040EZ, 1040A, and 1040 with schedules. However, please see a professional tax preparer for complicated returns. For a specific list of tax forms that can be completed by the AARP preparers, please contact the Center. There is no
