



Paddlewheel Cruise and Lunch in September

A very popular outing in previous years is on the calendar again next month. On **Thursday, September 21st** we'll meet at Pottawatomie Park in St. Charles at 11:15; leaving the dock at 11:30 for a 1½ hour private cruise & lunch on a St. Charles Paddlewheel Riverboat. We're hoping to see some autumn colors. The 65 foot riverboats have been cruising north up the Fox River past several parks and forest preserves since 1945. The lower deck is enclosed and you can also venture to the upper deck for a different view. The boats are not air conditioned or heated, but generally sail, rain or shine. There's a restroom onboard. During our private cruise, we'll enjoy a buffet lunch of southern pan fried chicken, potato salad, hot baked beans, coleslaw, rolls, cake and ice cream, and coffee and lemonade. Dutch painter Vermeer's extraordinary paintings of domestic life, with their subtle play of light and texture, have come to define the Dutch golden age. His portrait of the anonymous **Girl with a Pearl Earring** lies at the heart of **Tracy Chevalier's** novel of the same title. *Girl with a Pearl Earring* centers on Vermeer's prosperous Delft household during the 1660s. When Griet, the novel's quietly perceptive heroine, is hired as a servant, turmoil follows. First, the 16-year-old narrator becomes increasingly intimate with her master. Then Vermeer employs her as his assistant--and ultimately has Griet sit for him as a model. The club will meet on **Tuesday, August 29 at 10:00** to discuss this book.
