Stay Well!

The 2022 flu season is predicted to be very different. Masking during the last couple of years was responsible for a significant drop in flu cases. There are many reasons to get an influenza (flu) vaccine each year.

Seasonal influenza, like COVID-19, is a contagious respiratory illness that disproportionately affects adults ages 65 and older. Flu vaccination has been shown in several studies to reduce severity of illness in people who get vaccinated but still get sick. Unfortunately, because the Visiting Nurses are not administering flu shots this year outside of their own clinics, the Center will not be conducting a flu shot clinic in 2022. Flu vaccine is readily available; visit your doctor's office or an area pharmacy soon to get a shot. If you become sick, you also can help prevent the spread of the flu by staying home and away from others.
