#### The Four C Notes at the Jacob Henry Mansion

On Wednesday, September 25 a group will travel from the Center via luxury coach bus to Joliet for lunch and a show at the mansion featuring the Four C Notes. The Four C Notes was created by John Michael Coppola, best known for his appearance in Chicago's long running production of the Broadway smash hit, Jersey **Boys**. They are the Midwest's only tribute band dedicated to recreating the music of Frankie Valli and the Four Seasons. The visit will include a self-guided tour of the mansion, and a tour of the Old Central Church located on the grounds. The lunch menu features a Garden Salad, Garlic Bread, Cheese Manicotti, Fettuccini Alfredo & Spaghetti & Meatballs, Coffee or Tea, and Cannoli Cake. Let us know if you have special dietary needs. The cost of this trip is \$65 (transportation, tour, lunch, and show). Cash or a check made out to Geneva Township will be accepted. We will depart the Center at approximately 9:30am for the one-hour trip and anticipate leaving Joliet at 3:00pm. Twenty-five tickets have been reserved for this sold-out event. Paid registrations are due no later than Friday, September 13. A waiting list will be started after we reach twenty-five paid signups.

A little history of the property... Jacob Henry moved to the Midwest from New Jersey, securing construction contracts for railroad projects in Illinois, Indiana and Ohio. He began construction in 1873 of a 40-room, 16,800-square-foot house, which cost \$70,000 to build and was completed in 1876. The district in which it was situated was called "Silk Stocking Row" because it was populated by families of wealth and influence. Henry's family owned the home until 1933, then lost it to the Depression. It passed through several hands until 1985, when a Joliet couple bought the home to save it from the wrecking ball. This wonderfully restored home is registered as a National Historic Landmark and now hosts private and special events.
