Denny has performed regularly in Branson, Missouri at The American Bandstand Theatre and Jackie B Goode's diner. His tribute to the joy of the holiday season will include a splash of Christmas classics and popular songs from the American Songbook. White Fence Farm is well known for its festive holiday decorations; you won't be disappointed! Prior to the show you'll be treated to a lunch of four pieces of White Fence Farm's world-famous chicken along with a baked potato. Refillable trimmings of cottage cheese, kidney bean salad, coleslaw, pickled beets, and homemade corn fritters with powdered sugar will be served. Since Gran died a few months ago, twenty-five-year-old Molly has been navigating life's complexities all by herself. No matter – she throws herself with gusto into her work as a hotel maid. But Molly's orderly life is upended the day she enters the suite of the infamous and wealthy Charles Black, only to find it in a state of disarray and Mr. Black himself dead in his bed. In this Shakespearean farce, Hero (Kate Beckinsale) and her groom-to-be, Claudio (Robert Sean Leonard), team up with Claudio's commanding officer, Don Pedro (Denzel Washington), the week before their wedding to hatch a matchmaking scheme. Their targets are sharp-witted duo Benedick (Kenneth Branagh) and Beatrice (Emma Thompson) – a tough task indeed, considering their corresponding distaste for love and each other. Meanwhile, Don John (Keanu Reeves) plots to ruin the wedding.
