

NEW Lizzadro Museum of Lapidary Art

On Wednesday, August 27, join us for a trip to the Lizzadro Museum of Lapidary Art in Oak Brook. Lapidary is the art of cutting and polishing stone. Lapidary has its roots in prehistory, as early humans began fashioning tools and weapons from stone. In time, these techniques were also used for items of personal adornment. Stone carving evolved as an art in many cultures throughout the world. During the 1950s, lapidary became a popular hobby in the United States. Much to see at Lizzadro – some of the favorites currently on display include Faberge-style flowers and animals, stone butterflies created in Oregon, and a collection of rocks and minerals that look like food. There's a museum gift shop, too! For this trip, transportation is on your own. We plan to leave the Center at 10:00am. Carpooling is encouraged! The Center will provide good driving directions to the museum. After spending about 1.5 hours there, we'll travel less than two miles to Oak Brook Center for a pre-arranged lunch (included in the trip fee). The cost of this outing is \$28. Please register by August 13 so we can make lunch plans.

Pullman National Historical Park Reminder

The Center trip to the Pullman National Historical Park on Thursday, September 11 is currently FULL. However, we will start a waitlist. If you are registered for this outing and haven't paid the all-inclusive trip fee of \$45, please do so no later than August 21st. Cash or a check made out to Geneva Township will be accepted for payment. After that date, all unpaid registrations will be cancelled, and we will fill openings with a wait-listed member. As a reminder, the Center group will travel by luxury coach bus to the Pullman Exhibit Hall for an orientation and overview before departing on an approximately 40-minute neighborhood walking tour conducted by the Historic Pullman Foundation. They'll explore the general history of Pullman (town and man), architecture, labor movement, railcars, and more. The bus will depart the Center at approximately 8:30am. Members are asked to meet at the Center by 8:15am. At the conclusion of the walking tour, we'll return to the Exhibit Hall for a catered lunch.
