NEW *On Your Feet!* at Drury Lane Theatre

On Your Feet! is the inspiring true story about heart, heritage and two people who believed in their talent – and each other – to become an international sensation: Emilio and Gloria Estefan. This musical highlights the couple's struggle to break into the American music industry, their romance, and their resilience following a near-fatal tour bus accident. You'll want to dance in the aisle to the exhilarating tunes of **Miami Sound Machine**. Songs featured include "Rhythm Is Gonna Get You," "1-2-3," "Coming Out of the Dark," and the title song "Get On Your Feet". On **Wednesday, March 18** a group will travel to Drury Lane. The total cost (round-trip luxury coach transportation, ticket, and lunch) is \$75. Cash or a check made out to Geneva Township will be accepted for payment. Tickets are reserved and limited. **The sign-up deadline is February 24.** Upon arrival and prior to the show, attendees will enjoy a three-course lunch at Drury Lane. The lunch includes a mixed green salad, choice of entrée, and dessert. Coffee, tea (both iced and hot), or soft drinks are included. The entrée choices are Grilled Chicken Breast (white wine reduction and herb sauce, roasted wedge potatoes, green beans) or Bistro Steak Au Poivre (peppercorn sauce, potato purée, green beans). The novel follows a biracial Korean American family in Virginia whose lives are upended when their beloved father and husband goes missing. The story is told from the perspective of Mia, the 20-year-old daughter who is home from college due to the pandemic. She at first isn't concerned when her father and younger brother Eugene don't return from a walk in a nearby park. However, then Eugene runs through the front door bloody and alone. It's clear their father is missing; however, Eugene has the rare genetic condition Angelman syndrome and cannot speak. So, the family doesn't know what happened. All are welcome. Make an AARP Tax Appointment

Your 2025 Federal and IL tax returns will be completed and electronically filed for FREE. Appointments are available on Tuesdays and Thursdays each week for all dates **beginning Tuesday, February 3, 2026**. Most tax forms including 1040EZ, 1040A, and 1040 with schedules can be completed. A photo ID (driver's license, State ID, passport), social security card or Individual Taxpayer Identification notice, a copy of last year's tax returns, all income documents like W2's and 1099's, brokerage statements, and any other tax information specific to your situation must be presented at your appointment. **Appointments are required and can be scheduled by calling the Center at 630/232-3602.**
